Comprehensive Human Sexuality Education HB 19-1032

Comprehensive Human Sexuality Education, Colorado House Bill 19-1032, clarifies the curriculum allowable for Sex Ed in Colorado Public Schools. This Bill requires public schools to use graphic sexual intimacy displays, promote abortion as a normal form of birth control, bans certain uses of male and female pronouns. Additionally, this Bill limits parents' ability to opt their children out of such graphic courses.

The following statement was issued by a Weld GOP Spokesperson:

“The indoctrination of our children needs to end! For years, conservatives have been calling out the dysfunction in public schools across America. The same is true, right here, in Weld County. Just when we thought that the public school system couldn't force indoctrination any further, Colorado Democrats, Planned Parenthood, and a lone Republican bring forward a bill that is so intrusive, it removes the rights of parents.

House Bill 1032 requires 'Human Sexuality Education' be taught to students throughout Colorado. This curriculum that is being considered uses graphic images of reproductive organs and the acts of sexual intimacy of both heterosexual and homosexual relationships. Additionally, this course teaches full-span birth control; however, it limits the discussion around abstinence-only birth control and brings abortion in as if it were the same as using a condom or taking a daily pill.

Parents have the right to determine what their children are taught! This legislation is a sick attempt to remove the role of parents and force more of the liberal agenda on all of our children.”
